

WELCOME TO THE ROSSMOYNE BOWLING CLUB

WHEN IS THE CLUB OPEN

The Club is open almost every day from approximately 8am in the morning until the bar closes at night, and this is dependent on the number of guests using the bar. As a member you are welcome to enter the Club during the opening hours and use the facilities accordingly. Details of the Bar opening hours are shown below.

HOW DO I GET TO HAVE A GAME OF BOWLS

Your level of membership will determine your eligibility to use the Greens. Ordinary, Junior and Social Bowling members are the only categories that may use the Greens.

If you are new to bowling then I suggest you contact one of our Club coaches to get you started and set you off in the right direction. If they are not available just ask anyone for assistance and I am sure they will provide you with a loan set of bowls, direct you to the Green and get you started.

The Club Fixture Booklet details the games schedule for the year, this is a good guide to let you know what is happening. The Notice Board as you enter the Club also shows what games are currently being organised for the next week or two.

WHAT DO I NEED TO WEAR

To enter the Club a neat standard of dress is required (singlets and thongs are not acceptable). To walk on the Green you must be wearing flat soled shoes (bowling green approved) alternatively barefoot or with socks is acceptable.

WHERE CAN I FIND INFORMATION

Our website or Facebook is a good place to start for basic general information. There are a number of Notice Boards within the Club that also display current and relevant information. If the information you seek is not readily available once again please do not hesitate to ask.

The original buildings and infrastructure have been added to, and modernised with time. The four grassed greens have been converted to three world class synthetic greens with one green completely under a large roofed area.

The Club has had a long and recognised association with Bowls WA hosting many state and country events. The Club is also an active and competitive member of the Bowls WA Pennant competition.

The magnificent premises and surrounds that we have today, can be attributed to the hard voluntary work provided by its members both past and present.

OUR CLUB

The Club has approximately 330 members (180 bowlers, 150 social and others) offering a wide range of services designed to meet the needs of all members, whether playing competitive lawn bowls or darts, or simply enjoying the great social environment. We have three high quality synthetic bowling greens under flood lights, with one green completely roofed for all weather use. We have a spacious and comfortable club house with well-equipped outdoor areas. The Club operates under the rules of an incorporated body with a constitution and by-laws that are governed by an elected executive committee and various sub-committees under the stewardship of a president.

The Club is a smoke free environment. Members should also be aware that, under the Liquor Licensing laws, the greens are not licensed and therefore members are not permitted to consume or carry alcohol onto the greens.

OUR MISSION – October 2016

The Mission of the Rossmoyne Bowling Club is to foster the game of bowls through the provision of excellent bowling and club facilities, in a friendly, positive and supportive environment.

We will achieve this by:

- Having respect for and appreciation of fellow members, guests and supporters.
- Commitment to our training and game preparation in a manner befitting our Club
- Involving our Club in the community by making our facilities available to various institutions and groups.

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

The Club currently has seven different membership categories. Each category providing a different level of service and cost to suit our member's needs. The cost of membership, plus an Affiliation fee is determined each year by the Management Committee.

The categories are:

Life membership	- all the privileges of the Club
Ordinary membership	- all the privileges of the Club
Junior membership	- all the privileges of the Club but no voting rights
Social Bowling membership	- some bowling privileges of the Club but no voting rights
Social membership	- no bowling privileges but can use the Club facilities
Honorary membership	- persons of distinguished position or attainment
Associate membership	- limited privileges of the Club
Temporary membership	- day visitor to the Club

As a member of a bowling club you are entitled to visit and use the facilities of other bowling clubs affiliated with Bowls Australia. Just present your membership card and comply with their requirements. I am sure every Club will make you feel very welcome.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

Members of the Club have individual and collective responsibility for their personal conduct and that of their guests. Consistent with our values, member behaviour should reflect our friendly safe and happy environment.

MEMBERSHIP FEES – 2018/19

- i. Ordinary Membership (Older than 18years) - \$290 pa
Entitled to use all Club facilities, hold office and vote.
- ii. Junior Membership (12 to 18 years) – Concessional Fees apply
Entitled to play bowls, but may not use the Bar facilities, hold office or vote.
- iii. Social Bowling Membership - \$145 pa
Entitled to play in any Social competitions at our club, but not Pennants or Championship events. Cannot vote but may be a member of a sub-committee.
- iv. Social Membership (Older than 18 years) - \$50 pa
Entitled to use the Club facilities but may not play bowls. May not hold office or vote.

TAKING UP BOWLS FOR THE FIRST TIME?

Congratulations - Everyone can enjoy the fun game of lawn bowls – any age, any gender, any combination. The game can be extremely enjoyable, challenging and frustrating all at one time, requiring a combination of skill, tactics, team play, concentration and determination.

COACHING

Bowling looks easy – and it is – once you grasp the basics. The recommended way to start your bowling career is to utilise the services of our free Club Coaches. Our senior coach Allan Petchell was awarded in 2016 the Bowls WA Coach of the year for recognition of his fantastic contribution to coaching. Allan is currently the State Assistant Coach and is heavily involved in our School Bowling Program. You would be hard pushed to find anyone better! The Club also has three other coaches to help and support Allan.

BOWLS

The Club will loan you a set of “Club Bowls” to use whilst learning the art of lawn bowling. We therefore recommend you postpone any proposed purchase of bowls until you are aware of your requirements. Your Coach will help you determine the correct size and make to suit your need.

Second hand bowls can be purchased for approximately \$100 to \$300. A set new bowls will cost in the order of \$400 to \$600.

SOCIAL BOWLS

As a new bowler we would suggest you commence playing some games socially, where the competition is not as demanding. Coaching and social games are played in “mufti” (casual clothes). Your coach can advise you on what games are available to get you started.

BOWLS PRACTICE - (also known as “having a roll-up”)

Members are encouraged to practise as often as possible. Greens that are marked as “open” may be used at any time for roll-ups. Roll-ups are permitted prior to a social game but certain rules apply for roll-ups prior to Pennants and other competitions.

As you become more familiar with the Club’s setup you will soon realise that a large number of members do participate in “roll-ups” throughout the week and they will soon invite you to join them.

COMPETITIVE BOWLS

Once you have mastered the basic skills and have the confidence to progress further, you will have the opportunity to join the more competitive side of bowls – this may not suit all members – the choice is yours.

The general recognised competitive section of bowls is known as “Pennants” both Ladies and Men’s. Pennants are played over a 20-week period during summer and involves inter Club Competition. A good way to meet and associate with other players throughout the metropolitan area.

The Club also runs a number of Championship events, Bowling Carnivals and other competitions all designed to meet the needs of bowlers of varying ability.

If you are interested in playing Pennants or other competitive forms of bowls then a Club uniform (that complies with Bowls WA specifications) will need to be worn. The uniform can be purchased through the Club, your Coach will once again advise on this matter.

GREEN FEES

The maintenance and future replacement of our playing greens is supported by the payment of a "Green fee" payable for the entry into all competitive games. The fee is currently \$10 per day of competition.

OFFICE BEARERS AND COMMITTEES

The Management and day to day operation of our Club is run by our yearly elected Management Committee and its sub-committees. The structure of the committee is such that specific tasks are allocated to specific members of the committee. A complete list of all our current committee members is displayed in the Club foyer.

SOME INITIAL GUIDELINES ON THE ETIQUETTE OF BOWLS

There are some basic etiquette guidelines for new bowlers to follow. These are designed to make a game more enjoyable for all involved whilst protecting our greens from wear and tear.

- Never drop your bowls onto the green as this causes indentations
- Please do not sit on the banks of the green with your feet on the green or in the ditch.
- When you have finished your turn bowling please return to a position behind all bowlers who are awaiting their turn to bowl.
- Try not to move or speak when someone is delivering their bowl as this can be distracting.
- Drinking and smoking on the actual green is prohibited. The Club house and banks are licensed, but the greens are not.
- It is customary to offer to buy your opponent a drink after the game.
- Players are encouraged to have fun whilst respecting fellow bowlers. We all play bowls for enjoyment and companionship. Positive support of fellow players is encouraged.

SOCIAL SECTION

If bowling is not for you then please consider joining as a Social member of which we currently have some 150 odd members. As a Social member you can enjoy all the facilities, and social functions of the Club, except the use of the bowling greens.

Our Social committee is very active; organising fortnightly meals; Friday evening fun nights with raffles and novelty games; dinner dancers and entertainment. Please make sure the Secretary has your latest e-mail address so that we can send you details of upcoming events as well as our regular newsletter.

OPENING HOURS

The Club is generally open every day of the year (except Christmas and Easter).

Members can gain access to the Club after 8am in the morning until the bar closes in the evening. The Bar open and closure time can vary depending on a number of factors but the general times are as shown.
